NSW TEACHERS' FEDERATION STRIKE ACTION

By now, all community should have received messaging that the NSW Teachers Federation has directed its membership to take industrial action in the form of a **24-hour strike tomorrow on Thursday 30 June, 2022.** As a result of this strike action, Bilambil Public School will experience significant teacher shortages and means we encourage students to remain home and only attend school if absolutely necessary.

Our school will remain open but normal programming will not be possible. This means that while a restricted level of supervision will be available for students who do come to school, normal classes and programming will not be available, with many classes needing to be split or reformed for the day. We appreciate your support and understanding during this disruption.
